

Further Notice of By-election

Maketu Community Board

The nomination period to fill the extraordinary vacancy for the Maketu Community Board closed at midday Thursday 5 September 2024. Nominations have been received from Susan (Huhana) Smith and Brett Waterhouse.

As there were more nominations received than there were vacancies, a voting process will be required to determine the successful candidate and will be conducted by postal voting using the First Past the Post (FPP) electoral system. Voting will open on Thursday 10 October and will close at 12 noon on Friday 1 November 2024. Candidate names will be listed in random order on the voting papers.

Special voting facilities for this by-election will be available from either the Te Puke Library & Service Centre, 130 Jellicoe Street, Te Puke or Council's main office, Barkes Corner, 1484 Cameron Road, Greerton, Tauranga during normal office hours from Thursday 10 October until 12 noon on Friday 1 November 2024.
