Further Notice of By-elections

Maketu-Te Puke Ward and Ōmokoroa Community Board

The nomination period to fill the extraordinary vacancies for the Maketu-Te Puke Ward and Ōmokoroa Community Board closed at midday Wednesday 22 May 2024. Nominations have been received from:

As there were more nominations received than there were vacancies for both positions, a voting process will be required to determine the successful candidates and will be conducted by postal voting using the First Past the Post (FPP) electoral system. Voting will open on Wednesday 26 June 2024 and close at 12 noon on Thursday 18 July 2024. Candidate names will be listed in random order on the voting papers.

Special voting facilities for these by-elections will be available from either the Te Puke Library & Service Centre, 130 Jellicoe Street, Te Puke; the Ōmokoroa Library & Service Centre, 28 Western Avenue, Ōmokoroa or Council's main office, Barkes Corner, 1484 Cameron Road, Greerton, Tauranga during normal office hours from Wednesday 26 June 2024 until 12 noon on Thursday 18 July 2024.
