
# Big projects can be like big puzzles



Over the coming 18 months there is a lot of mahi happening in around Ōmokoroa. It's almost like putting together a very large jigsaw puzzle.

Rest assured, our teams are great at puzzles and are working hard to help minimise traffic impacts with all these projects.



## What we want to achieve

## SH2 roundabout

#### Delivery: April 2026.

**Objective:** Increase the safety and traffic flows to and from Ōmokoroa.

**Progress in the next 6 months:** Most of the works will be completed off-line with minimal traffic control, which includes service relocation and building off-line pavements.

## **Prole Road**

#### Delivery: May 2025.

**Objective:** Urbanising of Prole Road to allow for future development and subdivision.

**Progress in the next 6 months:** The roundabout at the intersection of Ōmokoroa Road and Prole Road should be completed prior to Christmas, with an anticiapted completion date by the end of May.

## Prole Road to EMT Line

#### Delivery: April 2026.

**Objective:** Urbanising the existing road, creating a 3m wide shared footpath, and 4 laning the existing pavement up to Flounder Drive.

**Progress in the next 6 months:** Service relocation, earthworks, and retaining wall construction.

## SH2 to Prole Road

Delivery: April 2026.

**Objective:** Establish a 4 lane Ōmokoroa Road fom SH2 to the roundabout, and build a portion of Industrial Road.

Progress in the next 6 months: Begin construction of the Industrial Road project construction of the temporary stormwater pond and associated stormwater diversion, completion of service relocation and earthworks for the project.

### **Heartwood Ave Bridge**

**Commencement date:** October 2024.

Delivery: May 2025.

**Objective:** Create pedestrian access from Heartwood Ave to Tui Glen. The bridge has been designed so that in the future, the bridge can be widened to allow for vehicles to flow through.

**Progress in the next 6 months:** The project should be nearing completion within the next 6 months.
