Hi Jemma,

As raised at the NOR hearing for the Active Reserve held on Friday 15 September 2023 and the subsequent Panel Directions, I can confirm that Council, in its capacity as future landowner/requiring authority, would not unreasonably withhold support/approval to the granting of consent to allow the current storage shed operation to continue under similar terms and conditions for a defined period that aligns with the reserve development timeframes.

Any such resource consent would need to be processed and approved by Council in its capacity as a regulatory authority, but from a future landowner perspective I don't see any reason why the operation should not be allowed to continue (if this is the landowner's preference) until the land is required for development as an active reserve (recreation reserve). Consideration to this arrangement can be addressed through the PWA acquisition process.
