The Application

The days and hours sought are **Monday to Sunday 11.00am to 11.00pm.** These days and hours are within the operative Western Bay of Plenty Local Alcohol Policy.

If they wish to open earlier for food and coffee that is a matter for them to decide.

The applicant has provided a detailed menu of the food options they intend to sell and the low alcohol and non-alcoholic refreshments that will be available.

The food is prepared on site and the inspector is satisfied that it is of an acceptable variety and price range and that a range of food offered can be provided within a reasonable time of placing an order.

The

A Building and Planning Certificate has been sought and issued showing the activity meets Town Planning requirements and the Building Code.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The application has received positive reports from the Inspector and the Police. The Medical Officer of Health has not reported on the application.

The inspector reports that the amenity and good order of the area is unlikely to be reduced by more than a minor extent and that the applicant has sound host responsibility practices.

The first year of a new licence is often called the 'probationary year' and no doubt the regulatory agencies will monitor the licence from time to time.

Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 & 106 of the Act.

We consider the application on the papers.



THE APPLICATION

This is an application by **Tetaihi Limited** for an **On-Licence** in respect of premises situated at **6/97 Hamurana Road**, **Ōmokoroa**, known as "**The Coffee Club"**.

The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of an **On-Licence - Class 3 Restaurant.** The business is a new venture, and the provision of food will be the principal source of sales revenue.

The days and hours sought are:

Monday to Sunday 9:00 am to 10:00 pm

These hours are in line with those permitted in the Western Bay of Plenty Local Alcohol Policy.

The premises for which a licence is sought is part of a new development in The Village, Ōmokoroa. Being a completely new development there is no existing licence in place that would enable the applicant to use a temporary authority.

The application was notified in the Weekend Sun on the 15th and again on the 22nd of March 2024. There have been no objections to the application received by the Secretariat Dispersions.

The applicant has provided a comprehensive menu of the food options that they intend to sell and the low alcohol and non-alcoholic refreshments that are available.

The planning and building certificate pursuant to section 100(f) has been received.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Police have reported on the application with no matters in opposition. The Medical Officer of Health (MOoH) has not reported on the application within the required time frame. Pursuant to section 103(4) of the Act it is assumed that the MOoH has no matters in opposition.

The Inspector reports that the amenity and good order of the locality is unlikely to be adversely affected by more than a minor extent by the effects of the issue of the licence. The applicant company has two directors/shareholders, one of which, Kelly Bain is the holder of a general manager's certificate. The applicant has indicated that once a licence is granted, Jessica Bain and one other staff member will be applying for managers certificates.

From the information supplied with the application it appears that this is this company's first endeavour in running a licensed premises. it is important that the applicant understands that the first year is often called the 'probationary year' and that the regulatory agencies will be monitoring how the licence is being operated.

Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 & 106 of the Act.

The application is considered on the papers.

The business is a franchised, open-plan store with shelves and aisles holding food products and other household goods on all sides and a single alcohol area (SAA) in one corner of the store.

The application was notified in the BOP Times on the 20th and 2 to 1 february 2024 no objections were received from members of the public.

Neither the Police, nor the Medical Officer of Health have raised any matters in opposition.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The application is complete and contains all the necessary considerations as required under s.100 of the Act. It was duly advertised, and no public objections were received.

We are pleased to see that this applicant has embraced the need for additional discretionary conditions and by consent they will be applied. For Te Puke New World this means there must be no single serves of mainstream beers and if products such as Godfather or Kingfisher Strong are sold, they are to be indelibly marked as detailed in condition 7 below.

Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 and s.112-115 of the Act.

Accordingly, I deal with the matter on the papers.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **approves** an application by **SD & SY Rolton (2023) Limited** for the renewal of an OFF Licence in respect of premises situated at 12 Jocelyn Street, Te Puke, known as "Te Puke New World" subject to conditions.






